NPSMA Collecting Enrollment and Graduation Data from all PSM Programs

The NPSMA is in the midst of creating a standardized annual collection of PSM student enrollment and PSM graduate data for all degree programs. Program Directors were sent unique identifiers to allow them to enter a portal on the NPSMA website where they could update program contact information and enter enrollee and degree data.

This information is vital to continue to advance the PSM Movement by providing those in the PSM field with regularly updated information describing our students and alumni. As the PSM field continues to grow rapidly this data collection also will provide an opportunity to analyze some of its demographic trends.

The NPSMA will share the results with its PSM collaborators such as the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation and the Council of Graduate Schools so that our outreach and communications efforts are providing consistent and current information.

The goal is to present the final report of the 2008 enrollment and graduation data at the March 6 Quarterly PSM Workshop in Tucson (see information above).
